Electrohype 2006 is the fourth edition of the Electrohype biennial, this years exhibition will be presented in Lunds konsthall. The exhibition period is from December 9th 2007 to January 7th 2008, opening on Friday December 8th.

The exhibition Electrohype 2006 will present a number of rather quiet artworks ranging from complex installations to visual minimalism. Some artworks are running their own internal processes while other works are commenting in their style and expression. A common factor for all the works is that they are mirroring the influence of technology and new media in our view of esthetics and attitude toward the arts.

A major change for this edition of the biennial is that it will be presented in the city of Lund. Electrohype has previously organized three biennials in Malmo, the last biennial was presented in Malmo Konsthall during the winter of 2004 – 2005.

During the same exhibition period as the biennial Electrohype will also present an exhibition with the topic electronic art in public space at the Museum of Sketches in Lund.
